## B) Semester End Examination: 75 \%

i) Duration: The examination shall be of $21 / 2$ Hours duration
ii) Theory question paper pattern

- There shall be five questions each of 15 marks.
- All questions shall be compulsory with internal choice within the questions.
- Question may be subdivided into sub-questions $a, b, c \ldots$ and the allocation of marks depends on the weightage of the topic.


## Passing Standard

The learners to pass a course shall have to obtain a minimum of $40 \%$ marks in aggregate for each course where the course consists of Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination. The learners shall obtain minimum of $40 \%$ marks (i.e. 10 out of 25) in the Internal Assessment and $40 \%$ marks in Semester End Examination (i.e. 30 Out of 75 ) separately, to pass the course and minimum of Grade E to pass a particular semester A learner will be said to have passed the course if the learner passes the Internal Assessment and Semester End Examination together.
