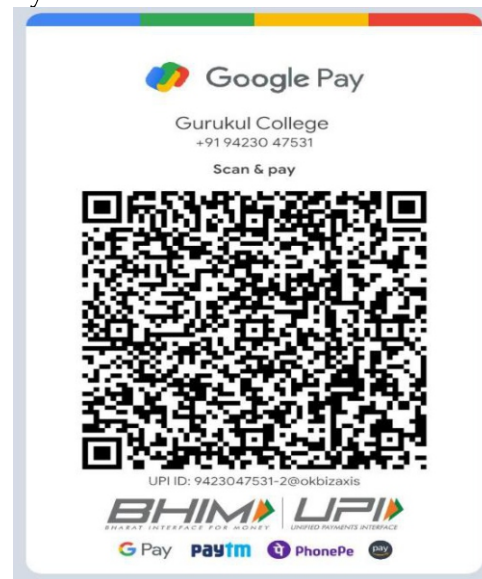

# CODE OF CONDUCT

- Entry and exit during lectures require permission from the teacher.

Under the guidance of the **University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi**, and the **University of Mumbai**, it is now **mandatory** for all students to register for an **ABC ID** from the academic year 2023-24.

The Academic Bank of Credits is a national-level digital facility that enables students to **accumulate, store, transfer, and redeem academic credits** earned from recognized institutions. It facilitates seamless student mobility between institutions and promotes a flexible learning framework.

## How to Create a Unique ABC ID Step-by-Step Flow?

- Complete your KYC (Know Your Customer) verification.

### → Step 2: Register on the ABC Portal

- Select **Sign Up via DigiLocker**.
- Link your DigiLocker account and submit your details.

### → Step 3: Get Your Unique ABC ID / APAAR ID

- Search for APAAR ID → Select **Admission Year**, **Identity Type** as Registration No → **Identity Value** as PRN or Application No → **Institution Name** as select **University of Mumbai** from the list → Get Document
- After registration, your **ABC ID** will be generated.
- Save your ABC ID and submit it to the College.

## **Course:- Bachelor of Commerce in Accounting & Finance**

The **Bachelor of Commerce in Accounting and Finance (BAF)** is a dynamic undergraduate program crafted for students aspiring to build a strong career in the financial world. Launched by the **University of Mumbai in 2003-04**, this three-year, six-semester course bridges academic knowledge with professional practice.

The BAF program focuses on equipping students with a deep understanding of accounting principles, taxation systems, auditing processes, financial analysis, and business laws. Along with core subjects, the course emphasizes the development of critical thinking, effective communication, and technical skills necessary for today's finance professionals.

Learning at BAF goes beyond the classroom – through **industrial visits, internships, practical training, case studies, seminars, and presentations**, students get hands-on exposure to the corporate environment.

**Graduates of BAF** are highly valued in industries like Banking, Consulting, Financial Services, Auditing Firms, and Corporate Finance departments.

<b>Eligibility</b> As per the Ordinance Number: O.5204	<b>12<sup>th</sup> Pass( any stream )</b> (a) A candidate for being eligible for admission to the Bachelor of Commerce (Accounting and Finance) degree course shall have passed XII std. Examination of the Maharashtra Board of Higher Secondary Education or its equivalent and secured not less than 45% marks in aggregate at first attempt (40% in case of reserved category). (b) Every candidate admitted to the degree course in the affiliated colleges conducting the course shall have to register enroll himself/herself with the University
<b>Duration</b>	3 year full time (Six Semesters) + 1 Year (Optional)

### **Duration of the Courses and Related information**

(a) The course shall be a full time course. The duration of the course shall be six semesters spread over in three years. Additionally as per NEP 2020, fourth year is Optional.

(b) A Batch shall consist of 60 students and will increase by 20% after permission from MU.

(c) Each semester having 22 credits, So per year 44 credits are allotted.

### **1. Carry Forward of Marks (ATKT Rules)**

In case a learner fails in Internal Assessment and/or Semester-End Examination in one or more courses, the following rules shall apply:

#### **1.1 Internal Passed, Semester-End Failed**

A learner who PASSES in the Internal Examination but FAILS in the Semester End Examination of the course shall reappear for the Semester End Examination of that course. However, his/her marks on the Internal Examinations shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled to the grade obtained by him/her on passing.

#### **1.2 Semester-End Passed, Internal Failed**

A learner who PASSES in the Semester End Examination but FAILS in the Internal Assessment of the course shall reappear for the Internal Examination of that course. However, his/her marks of the Semester End Examination shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled for the grade obtained by him/her on passing.

### **2. Rules for Progression (Allowed to Keep Terms - ATKT)**

**For Undergraduate (UG) Programmes:**

1. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester II irrespective of the number of courses failed in Semester I.
2. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester III if he/she earns a minimum of **32 cumulative credits** from Semester I and Semester II.
3. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester IV irrespective of the number of courses failed in Semester III.
4. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester V if he/she earns a minimum of **76 cumulative credits** from Semester I, II, III, and IV.
5. A learner shall be allowed to keep term for Semester VI irrespective of the number of courses failed in Semester V.
6. The result of Semester VI shall be withheld until the learner passes all courses from Semester I to Semester V.
7. A learner shall be eligible for admission to Semester VII (UG Honours / PG Part I) only if he/she has successfully passed all courses from Semester I to Semester VI (**minimum 132 credits**).

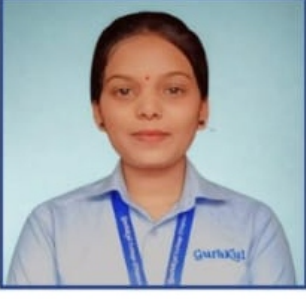

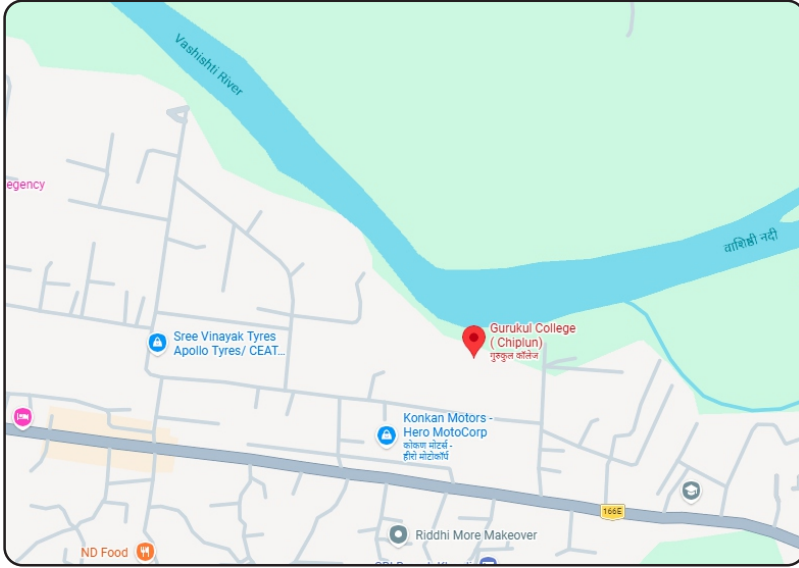
